Do not worry about high tech evidence - photos of activities taking place, artwork created and research undertaken is absolutely fine for Discover At Home.

If photo evidence is included, please do not include any identifiable children unless you can also give your explicit permission to share these images with us. Focus on the work rather than the child in the photos or videos.

If we do receive photos or videos of young people we will delete them as soon as the assessment for Discover is complete.

You are welcome to use the Logbook template provided by adding to it digitally, using it as a guide for creating your own or printing it out. There are also printed Discover Logbooks available for £4 each if you would prefer, and these can be posted to you.
