

Art Activities Online

You don't need lots of access to resources or expensive art materials to achieve Discover. Your felt pens will give you colour, or you can experiment with kitchen ingredients to paint with - soy sauce is a good ink substitute, and beetroot juice is a lovely red purple! You can use everyday things found at home to make art (eg using waste packaging with flour and water glue and newspaper to make junk models). You might like to follow one of the art activities on the list of suggestions we have provided below.

By choosing activities provided by local artists and arts organisations, you can make a follow up visit when buildings re-open, and maybe even arrange to interview the artist for your part B.
